

Application for Collector Vehicle Status



For a vehicle to be designated as a "collector vehicle," the owner or lessee must apply at time of registration or renewal and provide evidence of the following:

- 1. The vehicle is not qualified as a "historic vehicle," under N.J.S.A. 39: 3-27.3 et seq., or a "street rod" under N.J.S.A. 39: 3-27.27;
- 2. The vehicle is not driven more than 3,000 miles per year;
- 3. The vehicle is insured as a limited use "collector vehicle." (Proof must be supplied at time of odometer verification).
- 4. Vehicle must have been manufactured in a limited-edition quantity or that a limited quantity of the original production run remains.

A Collector Car Voucher must be purchased at a Motor Vehicle Agency for \$25.00. The Commission shall verify the odometer reading of a "collector vehicle" and may require that the vehicle be equipped with an odometer lock. A special decal, valid for five (5) years, will be issued indicating that the vehicle is exempt from safety and emission inspection. Upon receipt of an approval letter, please follow the instructions on how to obtain your sticker.
